#### **About Project Leadership:**

Project Leadership is an advocacy and leadership training program designed to increase the number of family members of children with special health care needs and/or disabilities who are prepared and supported to become advocates for health care policy and service improvements.

#### The Training of Trainers Workshop will:

Expand organizational training capacity to increase family involvement and engagement and empower families to engage in systems level leadership and advocacy.

#### **Eligibility:**

- Applicants must be employed by an organization representing and directly serving families of children with special health care needs and/or disabilities outside of California
- Organizations should have the capacity, resources, and desire to implement trainings locally
- After completing the workshop, attendees will be responsible for developing and submitting a strategy outlining plans to begin implementation within 12 months
